

## Terms and Conditions of use of Car Parking permits in the Wednesdayite Car Park

### 1. **Liability of Wednesdayite Limited - Company number 09140536 (Company)**

All persons entering the car park do so at their own risk and neither the Company nor any person acting on its behalf is in any way responsible for any loss, injury or damage sustained by them or for loss or damage to vehicles and their contents left within the car park.

### 2. **Responsibilities of Car Park users**

Persons using the car park should adhere to the Highway Code and must obey all signage. **Persons using the car park must obey directions from car park personnel.** If you cause any damage to a vehicle in the car park you must notify a member of staff and leave your registration and contact details immediately. You must ensure that your vehicle is parked in an appropriate manner at all times. Parking should either be as directed or in marked bays, do not park on double yellow lines or in the area reserved for disabled permit holders, unless you are a disabled permit holder. Should you breach this term we reserve the right to withdraw your permit without refund.

### 3. **Parking Period** Your car park permit entitles you to park one vehicle in the car park for any SWFC first team home league or cup fixtures (the match) for a period from three hours before the scheduled kick off time until **ONE HOUR** after the final whistle of the match at Hillsborough. Should your car remain in the car park after this time, we reserve the right to secure the car park. Should this occur a **release fee of £25** may be payable, to obtain release of your vehicle you should call **07877 282293**. Any such release fees paid are not refundable under any circumstances.

### 4. **Time of admittance.** We ask you to plan your journey to allow yourself sufficient time to arrive at the car park **no later than 15 minutes** before the scheduled kick off time of the match. Vehicles will only be admitted in the period 3 hours before kickoff until 15 minutes before kickoff. (i.e. between 12:00 and **14:45** for a 15:00 kick off or between 16:45 and 19:30 for a 19:45 kick off)

### 5. **Rights of the Company with respect of vehicles**

Every vehicle in the car park is subject to a lien for all charges due from the vehicle owner to the Company and the Company reserves the right to refuse to release your vehicle until those charges have been paid.

### 6. **Abandoned Vehicles**

Any vehicle left in the car park for more than 5 days may be considered abandoned.

The Company reserves the right to dispose of any vehicle it reasonably believes to have been abandoned. Before disposing of abandoned vehicles, the Company will make reasonable enquiries to identify and contact the registered keeper of the vehicle.

### 7. **Early termination of the use of the car park.** Should we receive notice of the termination of our lease during the season, we will notify you by email, using the email address given on purchase, of the last fixture you will be allowed to use the car park. Subject to you giving us appropriate banking details we will refund, within 28 days, part of the permit fee paid by you at the rate of £5 (disabled £3.50) per first team home league game still to be played. Should you wish to be paid other than by bank transfer a £5 handling fee will be deducted from any refund due to you. Once the termination date is reached the Company will have no further liability or obligation to you,

### 8. **Loss of permit** Should you lose your permit, please advise us by email to [paul.holmes@wednesdayite.com](mailto:paul.holmes@wednesdayite.com) as soon as you realise you have lost it. A £5 fee will be payable for the issue of a replacement purchase, should you then find the original permit you MUST return this to us.

### 9. **Acceptance of terms.** By using your permit, you confirm that you have read and understood the terms and conditions set out above along with the Further Guidance set out below.

#### **Further Guidance**

- Ensure your vehicle is locked and all windows securely closed.
- Ensure that any security lock is properly engaged and alarm system activated.
- Take all possessions with you when you leave your vehicle. If this is not possible, do not leave them where they are visible
